COMMON CONDITIONS AND TREATMENTS

ARTERIAL/VASCULAR TREATMENTS

- * Peripheral arterial disease (PAD)
- * DVT: Thrombectomy/thrombolysis
- * Venous outflow obstruction
- * Vascular malformations
- * Scrotal and labial varicosities

DIALYSIS

- * Fistula management and declot
- * Tunneled dialysis catheter placement

CANCER TREATMENTS

- * Chemoembolization
- * Y90 radioembolization
- * Tumor ablation in liver, lung, kidneys and bone (RFA, MWA and Cryo)
- * Spine/bone tumor RFA + kyphoplasty

VENOUS ACCESS

- * Chest port placement
- * Tunneled central lines

LIVER DISEASE

- * Transjugular liver biopsy and TIPS
- * Ultrasound-guided liver biopsy

VENOUS TREATMENTS

- * Spider veins
- * Varicose veins/venous insufficiency
- * Saphenous ablation
- * Phlebectomy Ambulatory

PELVIC PAIN

- * Uterine fibroids
- * Adenomyosis
- * Pelvic congestion syndrome
- * Testicular varicocele

HEADACHES

- * Sphenocatheter treatment

BACK PAIN

- * Compression fractures, kyphoplasty, spinal stimulators, spinal pumps
- * Chronic back pain, ESI, facet injections
